

# AEPS Website Forum Tips to Start A New Conversation on [www.aeps.org](http://www.aeps.org)

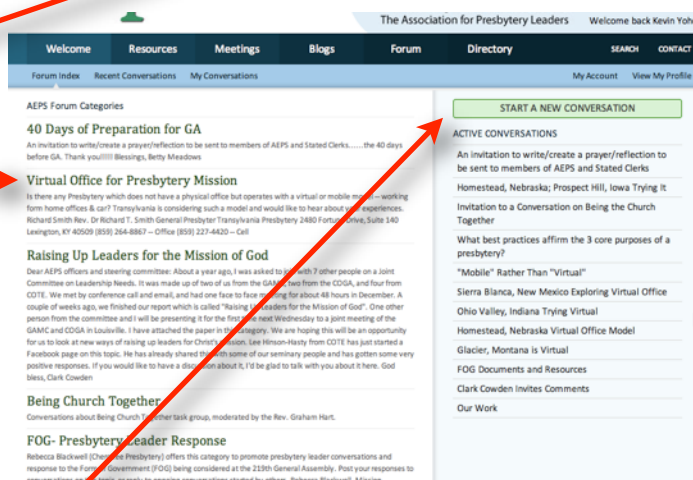
Visit [www.aeps.org](http://www.aeps.org) and notice the website organizing tabs:



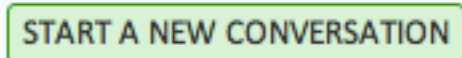
These tips refer to the Forum section. Go ahead, click the Forum tab.

Let's get started. Its easy. Could even be called fun. We hope you will post replies and even start your own conversations on the dozens of important conversations held across the church.



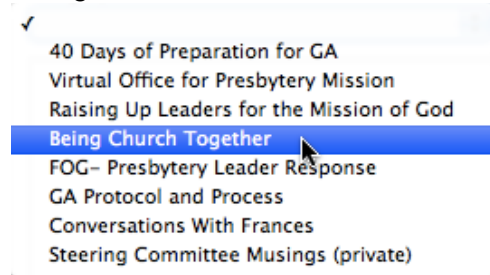
1. Click the button:



2. Enter a subject for your conversation. (For example, make a statement or response to a category of interest you see posted. Sample: "Invitation to a Conversation on Being the Church Together")

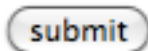

5. Submit your Reply.

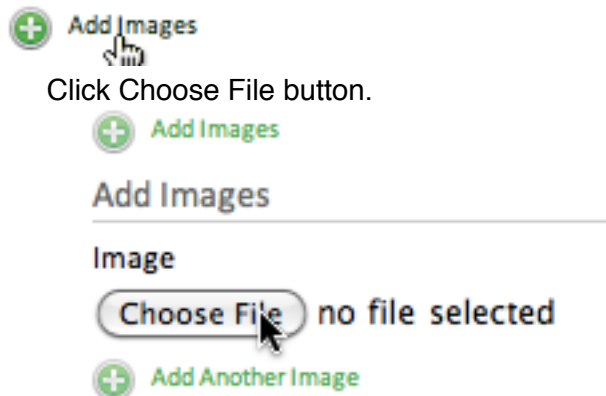

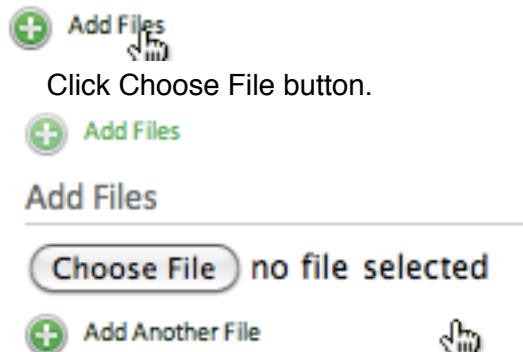
